## Take Voice Lessons?

Carroll Choir prides itself in being able to train all students, beginning and advanced, in the fundamentals of singing, tone production, diction, breath control, and sight-reading.

Unfortunately, we do not have many opportunities to individually work with students and fine-tune their abilities. Voice teachers fill in this gap. They can take what a student learns in the choir and augment it!

### Individual attention

A voice teacher can work with you and help you individually with:



- Pharyngeal Resonance
- Vowel placement
- Diction
- \* Male voice change
- \* Audition music (All State)
- \* Class Literature



### Solo Performance

You will have multiple opportunities to perform solo while working with a voice teacher. Twice a year you will perform in your voice teacher's student recitals. They will also help you prepare a song for the Solo and Ensemble Competition.



### Voice lessons sound great, but they are too expensive!

Our voice lesson teachers charge **\$25** for a half-hour lesson, an excellent deal given the caliber of voice teachers we are fortunate to have on staff! Comparable lessons elsewhere would cost significantly more.

Our voice teachers will schedule your lesson during your choir class period, so you do not have to change your schedule before or after school!
