**Jefferson Memorial:** Honoring our 3rd President, Thomas Jefferson, primary author of the Declaration of Independence

**World War II Memorial:** This memorial is dedicated to all who served during World War II. Military veterans, citizens on the home front, and the nation at large

**Vietnam Veterans Memorial Wall:** The memorial is inscribed with the names of the over 58,000 American's who gave their lives or remain missing.

**Korean War Veteran's Memorial:** Nineteen steel sculptures of ground troops moving toward freedom in Korea, with a striking 164-foot granite mural

**Lincoln Memorial:** Honoring our 16th President, Abraham Lincoln. The majestic 19-foot marble statue inside the memorial is flanked by inscriptions of Lincoln's Gettysburg Address
